A Note from Mike Sutton, President & CEO

Dear Habitat supporters – you are receiving the fifteenth edition of a monthly newsletter we've created, specifically designed for you – our Advisory Board Members, Board of Directors, Emeritus Trustees, Legacy Society Members, Community Builders Society Members, and major donors. The goal of this exclusive communication piece is to keep you better informed of current projects and future initiatives.

In the aftermath of Hurricane Ian, our thoughts and prayers are with our neighbors to the south. I hope that you and your families stayed safe during the storm. To support our neighbors during this difficult time, our Habitat affiliate has partnered with our fellow Tampa Bay region affiliates to provide relief to Southwest Florida. Habitat for Humanity of Pinellas & West Pasco, Habitat for Humanity of East & Central Pasco, and Habitat for Humanity of Hillsborough County are encouraging the community to donate funds and supplies to help our neighboring affiliates to the South.

While we are blessed to have been spared from the devastation from Hurricane Ian, we are heartbroken for the communities that were impacted. I have been in contact with the local affiliate in the area, including Lee & Hendry County and Charlotte County, which have seen a spectrum of damage, destruction and challenges. After speaking with the affiliate leaders, we identified the need for construction and cleaning supplies to start to prepare for rebuilding. A small team of Habitat Pinellas & West Pasco folks traveled to Punta Gorda earlier this week to help the Charlotte County affiliate repair damage to their office and ReStore.
