

### 2023 Best Places to Work

Nearly 900 people showed up Wednesday at George M. Steinbrenner Field in Tampa to celebrate workplaces they love. The Tampa Bay Business Journal's annual Best Places to Work program, now in its 17th year, comes at a time when business owners and employees across the Tampa Bay region are experiencing talent shortages. 
