The goal of this monthly communication is to provide you with insight into current and upcoming projects, events and initiatives designed in support of our mission.

As our team has now wrapped up the first few months of our new fiscal year, I thought it would be a great time to reflect on what we were able to accomplish in the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year. As you know, we were able to move 73 families into their decent, affordable home in the fiscal year and as far as we know, that puts us as one of the largest affiliates within the Habitat network! Let's look at what we accomplished over the last 12 months:

- Goal of 70 Homes 73 Homes Completed
- Raised \$33,451,826 in revenue
- Ended the year with a record 108 homeowners in the pipeline
- Named one of Tampa Bay Business Journal's Best Places to Work
- Named an ENERGY STAR Award Partner of the Year

Many of these goals will grow in the new fiscal year, and with support from our donors, volunteers, board members, and staff, we will achieve great success!
