## Dear Habitat Supporter,

Welcome to the twenty-ninth edition of The Community Builder newsletter!

This exclusive communication is specifically designed for you – our Advisory Board Members, Board of Directors, Emeritus Trustees, Legacy Society Members, Community Builders Society Members, and major donors. The goal of this monthly communication is to provide you with insight into current and upcoming projects, events and initiatives designed in support of our mission.

As we wrap up our 2023-2024 fiscal year, I have been reflecting a lot over the last 12 months. I am so proud of our organization – for the culture we have built and continue to refine; for the team's focus and determination to serve more families; and for the work we've done to establish Habitat Pinellas & West Pasco as the leader in affordable housing in our region.

We finished off the fiscal year with 81 homes built in our community. The 81 homes this year sets another record for the number of homeowners served in a fiscal year over our 39-year history. In addition to 81 homes, we raised more than \$35M in revenue and celebrated our 900th home (we are now at 910!), while setting the stage for Habitat into the future.


