Dear Habitat Supporter,

Welcome to the thirtieth edition of The Community Builder newsletter!

This exclusive communication is specifically designed for you – our Advisory Board Members, Board of Directors, Emeritus Trustees, Legacy Society Members, Community Builders Society Members, and major donors. The goal of this monthly communication is to provide you with insight into current and upcoming projects, events and initiatives designed in support of our mission.

As we close out the first month of the new fiscal year, we are set up for success on the road to 85 homes! Homeowner candidates are as determined as ever to change the trajectory of their lives, volunteers are hard at work on site building homes, and our supporters are engaging with us in new ways, including our newly imagined golf tournament: the Golfing Fore Habitat Topgolf Challenge!

We know that the work Habitat is doing is more important than ever. We are seeing and hearing from record numbers of individuals and families inquiring about our program each month. While it is impossible to serve all of them, our affiliate will have a life-changing impact on these 85 families this fiscal year.

Between 2014 and 2023, Habitat for Humanity of Pinellas and West Pasco Counties saw an increase of 265% in the number of homes built each year. While the increase alone is impressive, the mission accomplishment it represents is even more so. It means bringing communities together, building hope, and breaking the cycle of poverty for more families every year.

Over the course of the next month, we will be diving into our new 3-year strategic plan. This plan was carefully crafted by a 12 person team – 6 staff and 6 board members – and adopted by our board of directors at the end of June. Habitat will engage in following this strategic direction for the next three years to build on this momentum and continue to fulfill our mission.

Thank you for your ongoing partnership. Together, we will continue to move the mission forward to build more homes, communities and hope.

Florida Trend's 2024 Best Companies to Work for in Florida

Habitat for Humanity of Pinellas and West Pasco Counties is proud to announce that we have been named one of Florida's Best Companies To Work For in 2024. The annual Best Companies To Work For In Florida list featured in the August issue of Florida Trend magazine ranks 100 companies in small, medium, and large employer categories.

To participate, companies or government entities were required to have at least 15 workers in Florida and to have been in operation for at least one year. Companies that chose to participate underwent an evaluation of their workplace policies, practices, philosophy, systems, and demographics. The process also included a survey to measure employee satisfaction. The combined scores determined the top companies and the final ranking.

The Best Companies To Work For In Florida program is managed by Florida Trend and Workforce Research Group and is endorsed by the HR Florida State Council. Workforce Research Group managed the registration, survey, and analysis and determined the final rankings.

Habitat Pinellas & West Pasco was also recently named a Tampa Bay Business Journal 2024 Best Places to Work honoree and a Tampa Bay Times 2024 Top Places to Work honoree. These three awards are a testament to the exceptional culture of collaboration and support that our Board of Directors and staff are fully committed to enriching.

Hernando Expansion

Habitat Hires Executive Director in Hernando County

Habitat for Humanity of Pinellas, West Pasco, and Hernando Counties has hired Whitney Dinu as Executive Director as it expands its service area into Hernando County.

In April of this year, Habitat for Humanity of Pinellas and West Pasco Counties was selected by Habitat for Humanity International to expand its service area into Hernando County. Habitat is dedicated to providing affordable homeownership opportunities to individuals and families in the community and build public-private partnerships throughout Hernando County to further the Habitat mission. The affiliate recently purchased its first lot in the area at 9504 Spring Hill Drive and will break ground in the coming weeks.

As Executive Director, Whitney Dinu will work closely with Habitat's president and CEO, Mike Sutton, to identify and execute growth opportunities and develop strategic alliances to further the Habitat mission in Hernando County and surrounding areas. The role will serve on Habitat's leadership team and help provide oversight to the organization.

Whitney Dinu brings over 15 years of experience in marketing, talent acquisition, and community engagement to her role as Executive Director at Habitat. Whitney has an extensive portfolio in relationship building and client solutions, having worked at ServPro, Kforce, and a private equity firm. As a fifth generation resident in Hernando County, Whitney's expertise of the area will allow her to make impactful, lasting connections between the County and Habitat.





Whitney Dinu will also work with executive leadership to recruit and create the Hernando Leadership Council. This group will include members of the community who willingly advocate for Habitat for Humanity, spread awareness of the homeownership program, and engage other stakeholders in the mission of Habitat.

Whitney Dinu holds a Bachelors Degree from the University of Florida. She resides in Brooksville, FL with her husband, Chris, and their two children, Ava and Jackson.
